

## Heads or Tails

## So, So Simple, and Almost No Set-up

The AW Surrey plays this quick and fun game at more formal events when members are dressed up and other "games" don't seem appropriate but can also be played at any sit-down occasion.

Start with a prize that everyone attending would like to win. For example, if it is couples, do not choose a handbag or perfume or a fishing rod and tackle. We usually go for a magnum of champagne as it appeals to everyone. We have been lucky that on each occasion, someone has donated the prize so that 100% of the proceeds go to the club.

A good time to play is between courses (if it is a sit-down dinner) but preferably after everyone has had a few drinks and are in a happy mood.

Ask everyone who wishes to play to put (any amount of money you decide on) in the bowl in the middle of the table. We asked for £5 per person (about \$7.50).

Those who have paid to play should stand up (those not playing remain seated). We have always had 100% participation!

The official caller (Master of Ceremony, Club President, special guest) should have a microphone and be visible to all the players.

Those playing are asked to put their hands on either their heads or tails (their backsides) and keep them there.

The chosen official flips a coin and calls out if it landed heads up or tails up.

If it is Heads Up, all those players with their hands on their heads remain standing. All others sit down. Obviously, the opposite if it is Tails up.

Continue playing until there is only one winner. It doesn't take too much time to play as the number standing decreases quickly.

This is so easy to play, and everyone enjoys it.
