## Objective 1: Provide immediate safety and wellbeing support

Survivors and vulnerable migrants receive RISE care packages with essentials, transportation home, emergency meals, short-term accommodation (up to 5 days), health/dental care, mental well-being and psychosocial counseling, and legal assistance.

### Deliverables:

- 100 individuals receive RISE packages
- 40 access safety and wellbeing support

## Objective 2: Build economic self-reliance

Activities include career/entrepreneurship guidance, vocational training, internship/job placement, and skills training (including on Pacific Links' Rise.GLOW online learning platform and PAXU safe migration app with AI-enhanced tools). Individuals also access savings matching, housing support (up to 3 months), and seed funding for small businesses.

### Deliverables:

- **40 individuals receive economic resilience support**

## Objective 3: Promote inclusivity and sustainable reintegration pathways

The project includes a **support line** for survivors and potential victims and training for stakeholders on inclusive, trauma-informed practices.

### Deliverables:

- 100 individuals access the support line
- 50 stakeholders trained

# Why Fundraising Matters

## The Power of FAWCO:

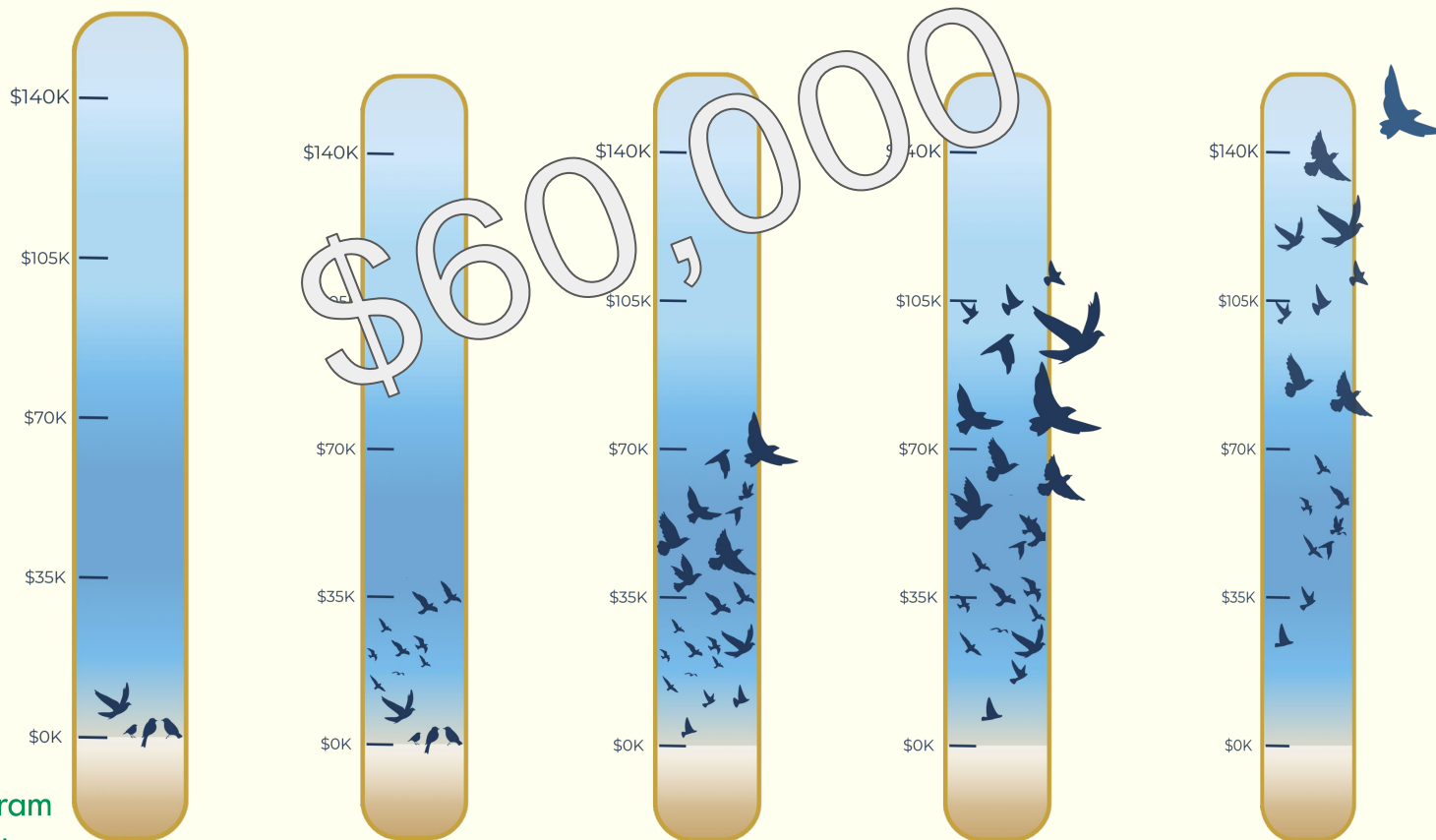

# Power Her Path Ripple Effect-60 Clubs

30 Clubs X \$500=\$15,000

40 Clubs X \$500= \$20,000

in 2 years = \$30,000 - \$40,000

**20 Clubs raise \$500=10,000**

**15 clubs raise 1000= 15,000**

**5 raise 3000=15000**

**Total is \$40,000**

| Total    | 20 clubs | 15,000 | 750         |

# Your Club Action Plan-Idea Lab
